

Dear Parishioners,

With great joy in my heart, I announce to you: "Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!" This ancient greeting sums up what we celebrate this Easter Sunday: the joy of Christ risen and alive in our midst.

"This is the day the Lord has made: let us rejoice and be glad". This, then, is the joyful Good News: Christ has conquered sin by his death and resurrection so we may live. The Resurrection is the foundation and cornerstone of our faith. As St. Paul says, if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is useless, and our faith too is in vain. On Easter Vigil we recall God's story – in our story of salvation. The liturgy of the Word re-enacts that story, and we joyfully celebrate the risen Lord in our midst as He offers Himself anew in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. We do this in a spirit of thanksgiving to God who gives His own Son to die in order to rescue us from the slavery of sin.

May we live as people deeply touched by the resurrection and proclaim: Christ is risen, Alleluia! May our encounter with the risen Lord on our journey of faith touch us deeply and transform us as He did for His Disciples. May the resurrection lead us to be the best version of ourselves, committed to living out our baptismal covenant.

When we live the new life of the resurrection, we become the best version of ourselves. We become what St Augustine referred to as an "Easter People", a people transformed into disciples and stewards who commit to giving their time, talent, and treasure in witness.

My prayer for you this Easter is that you live as people deeply touched by the resurrection and proclaim:

Christ is risen, Alleluia, Alleluia!

Gospel Reflection for Easter Sunday



Before Jesus, we could have expected a life after death, but it would have been a sad, dark existence far removed from the loving embrace of our Heavenly Father. However, now that Jesus has died for us and risen in glory, the gates of Paradise that had been closed to us because of Adam and Eve's sin have been opened up again. Not only do we have hope of living beyond this life, we have the hope that it will be a glorious, joyful existence. We won't just be souls drifting along aimlessly in a gray mist. But we hope to be resurrected - both body and soul - to rejoice in the presence of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit for all eternity.

The sad thing is that even though it has been almost two thousand years since Jesus rose from the dead, most people still live as if this world is all that there is. They are not even thinking about life after death. In their minds, earth is the only Paradise we can ever know. The only thing that makes sense to them is to live for today.

However, as Christians, the resurrection of Jesus Christ has opened up a new horizon for us. There is more to our existence than just our earthly life. Our eyes are fixed on more than what this world can offer. Rather, our goal is eternal life with Jesus. That is what we strive for. That is where our hope lies.

Saint Paul tells us in today's second reading, "So, if you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth" (Col 3:1-2 RSV).

This is the wonderful truth that we proclaim. Our resurrection from the dead and the eternal life that Jesus has won for us is not just a future event. It is not like a ticket we cash in on only after we die. It is a reality that we are already living because of our baptism. That is why Saint Paul can say, "SINCE you have been raised." He doesn't say WHEN you are raised or UNTIL you are raised. He talks about it as a reality that has already happened. Jesus' resurrection from the dead opened up a new possibility of life, which is ours, through baptism and faith.

Saint Paul puts this in his letter to the Galatians: "...I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me" (Gal 2: 19b-20 RSV).


Our life here on this earth is an extension of the risen life of Jesus Christ. If we have been baptized, then Christ is living in us. It is Jesus' breath in our lungs. It is His strength in our limbs. His love beats in our hearts, and His hope runs through our veins. We have been raised with Jesus, so our faith must guide us.

Jesus is counting on us as Christians to continue His work on this earth. Just as He healed, we must heal. Just as He spoke the truth, we must speak the truth. We must treat everyone with love and mercy, just as He did. And, if need be, we must give up our lives for others. That is how Jesus lived. That is how we must live. But we do it, not with our own human effort and willpower, but with His presence at work in and through us.

This is represented beautifully in the Eucharist. Because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, bread and wine can be transformed into His Body and Blood. He is truly present - not just symbolically - but really. It is the Risen Lord whom we receive in Holy Communion. If Jesus can change bread and wine into His Body and Blood and charge them with His risen life, what can He do to us? How thoroughly and completely can He transform us by His risen life to be His presence in the world?

That first Easter morning changed everything. Peter, John, and Mary Magdalene could never be the same once they saw that empty tomb and realized that Jesus had truly risen as He promised. They couldn't go back to living the way they did before. From then on, they preached to everyone who listened about the new hope God holds out to everyone who believes in Him and is baptized.

That is the challenge that is held out to us. Will we allow ourselves to be transformed by the resurrection of Jesus from the dead? Will we allow Him to live in and through us? Will we set our hopes not on what this world offers but on what God offers us through Jesus Christ? And will we bring that hope into this dark world by allowing the Risen Lord to reach others through us? That is what we are called to by our baptism - to transform this world by witnessing to the resurrection of Jesus from the dead.

Grief is the process by which healing takes place, but it can be hard work! Our Catholic faith can be a tremendous source of strength in helping us.


Our Parish Bereavement Ministry meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month in the Parish Conference Room.
